Space-Available and Space-Required Travel Eligibility (Space-A pg. 29, Space-R pg. 12, Categories pg. 39)

Ready to fly Space-A or Space-R?

- <u>Use this link</u> to register for a Space-A seat on any eligible outbound mission.
 a. If you do not want to register online, sign-up in person at Bldg 17005 (44 APS).
- a. If you do not want to register online, sign-up in person at Bidg 17005 (4)
 Trying to Fly on Official Orders aka Space-R? Use the Space-A link.
 - *a.* Under Dependents, input "Travelling on Official Orders".
 - **b.** Or feel free to come by Bldg 17005 (44 APS) to sign-up in person.
 - c. Space-R personnel travelling in groups of 6+, you must call or check-in in person
- 3. After you are registered, monitor our <u>72-hour schedule</u> for flight opportunities.
- 4. On your day of travel, ensure you have *all required documents*, along with your bags.
- 5. No later than one hour prior to roll call, arrive at the Terminal to "Mark Yourself Present."
 - a. 734 AMS Passenger Services will verify you have required documents.
 - **b.** Once you are marked present, you will be able to compete for a Space-A seat.
 - *c.* **Personnel can have travel documents reviewed in person** with a Passenger Agent during operating hours any time prior to your travel day.
- 6. During Roll Call, Passenger Agents will call out selected travelers by name.
 - a. Documents will be stamped finalized and 734 AMS Passenger Agents will collect your bags.
- 7. Passenger Service Agents will direct you to the Outbound Waiting Area and notify you when it's time to board.

Using the 734 AMS (Andersen AFB) AMC Travel Site:

- 72-Hour Schedule
 - This has all the flights that are eligible to carry personnel Space-A for the next 3 days!
 - This will tell you when to show, when the Roll Call occurs, the next stop, and number of planned seats
 - **Tentative Seats (planned)** are released 48-72 hrs prior to arrival, **Firm Seats (Actual)** are provided by the aircrew as late as aircraft arrival.

• Patriot Express Schedule

- The Patriot Express (PE) arrives the second and fourth weekend of every month
 - 734 AMS Passenger Services will publish a Sequence of Events (SOEs) 3-5 days prior to a Patriot Express.
 - SOE's highlight show times, Early Bird Check-in, and required documents
 - SOE's are also emailed to Leadership across Guam, ask your supervisor, Senior Enlisted Leader, or Commanding Officer!
- The Patriot Express only moves passengers between Kadena AB, Japan (Okinawa) and Seattle-Tacoma Intl, WA
- Roll Call
 - This is the recent Space-A and Space-R movements, planned seats, and actual seats filled
