

Sumay Cemetery

GHPI 66-03-1041

Location: Naval Base Guam

Difficulty Level: Easy (Roadside accessible)

Access (Tier 2): Naval Base access is required. Site is roadside accessible and is open for visitors with granted access. To enter the cemetery walls, the visitor must walk down a flight of steps.

Site Description:

CHamoru, Spanish, and English inscriptions marked 157 graves in the roughly 0.7-acre village cemetery in 1910. As a result of severe damage by American bombs during the July 1944 invasion, official cemetery records and grave markers became lost. However, it is not uncommon for old cemeteries to contain unmarked graves or graves outside the formal boundary line. Although many grave markers are found within the cemetery's walls today, it is uncertain how vast the graveyard actually extends.
