



About ECATTS

The Environmental Compliance Assessment, Training, and Tracking System (ECATTS) is a web-based training platform that provides environmental training to Navy military, civilian, and contractor personnel, worldwide. ECATTS is accessible from any computer with internet access. It is username and password protected, so use of a CAC card is not required.

ECATTS integrates Federal, State, and Local environmental laws, regulations, E.O.s, DoD/DON-specific environmental instructions and installation specific environmental policies into understandable requirements.

Installations registered with ECATTS have access to the vast library of environmental training topics that can be customized with site specific environmental training requirements. If your installation is not currently included in ECATTS, contact your ECATTS Representative on the POC list attached to this document. You may also contact the NAVFACHQ or the NAVSAFENVTRACEN POC on the attached list.



Registration

1. **Navigate to the Navy ECATTS website: <https://environmentaltraining.ecatts.com>**
2. **In the center section of the page, follow directions to create a profile for New Users (if you have a .mil email address, select "CLICK HERE" and a password will be sent to you immediately.)**
3. **Enter the registration password into the box.**
4. **Click "Create"**

After you create a profile you may develop a training plan based on your environmental duties by checking the box next to each module listed. Modules and quizzes can usually be completed in 20 minutes. You must obtain 100% on the quiz to get a certificate of completion. ECATTS will track your completion progress on your training plan or you can print your certificate for inclusion in your command or installation training tracking program.

ECATTS is portable. When you relocate to a new installation, simply update your profile with your new location and, if needed, create a new training plan based on your new job responsibilities.
